If you discover a fire, evacuate the local area and contact the showground headquarters immediately.

If you require medical assistance, contact either the first aid providers or the showground headquarters. The first aiders will be located in a prominent position.

Please remove all your rubbish from the site when you leave.

The society expects that all exhibitors vehicles shall be in a safe condition and be adequately insured to be at the event. The 5 mph whilst on the showground or in the car park must be strictly observed.
